ACT Cultures Crossing dances onto the Nottingham Sneinton stage

Art Culture Tourism / ACT presents its 7th exciting Cultures Crossing evening on Wednesday 27th March showcasing another fresh, diverse lineup of performers and presenting artists in its first foray into Nottingham City Centre hosted at Minor Oak co-working and business hub in Sneinton Market.
